The Government has issued the New Earnings Threshold Gazette as well as the New National Minimum Wage Gazette for South Africa.

As of 1 March 2023, the increased annual earnings threshold has been increased in the amount of **R241,110.59**. The new Earnings Threshold Gazette can be found here.
